The summer program at the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Nez Perce Tribe is for youth ages **5 to 18 and in grades Kindergarten-12th**. All participants **MUST** be registered **Boys & Girls Club members** to participate, **Annual membership & Summer registration fees are FREE of Charge** thanks to the Nez Perce Tribe.

-Summer programming & activities are provided by trained Boys & Girls Club Youth Development Professionals. Program areas of the Club include; **Gamesroom** (*Health & Wellness*), **Gym** (*Sports & Recreation*), **Education Center** (*Education*), **Arts & Crafts** (*The Arts*) & **Teen Center** (*Leadership & Service*).

-Available Boys & Girls Club summer programs offered for members are; **Project Learn** (*Mentoring*), **Triple Play** (*Sports & Recreation*), **T.R.A.I.L.** (*Diabetes Prevention*), **Brain Gain** (*Education*), **Keystone & Torch Club** (*Community Service*), **Diplomas2Degrees** (*College Awareness*) & **Jr. Staff/Career Launch** (*Job Readiness*).

## Summer Lunch Program

-The Clubhouse will be participating in the Lapwai School District's Summer Food Program (**FREE** of charge and **available to registered Club members**)

If your child chooses **NOT** to eat the provided lunch they may bring a sack lunch.

**\*PARENTS:** Please do not send any food items that require cooking, microwaving or preparing at the Clubhouse. (Ex: Top Ramen, Frozen Food, etc.)

-**LUNCH TIME** will be from **11:30am-12:30pm**. As part of the **Clubs Covid-19 policy & procedures**, Club members will be split into small separate groups to eat lunch and will be in separate designated areas of the Club.

**\*PARENTS:** Please remember any Club members that sign out & leave the Club facility at any point of the programming day will **FORFEIT** their spot at the Club for the rest of the day & will **NOT** be able to return to the Clubhouse until the next programming day. ## Boys & Girls Clubs of the Nez Perce Tribe Covid-19 Policy & Procedures

- Clubhouse will have a **50 CLUB MEMBER CAPACITY**. (1<sup>st</sup> come 1<sup>st</sup> serve basis). Waiting list will be made available & Club will notify Club members or parents of available spots.
- Clubhouse entrance procedures will be in place. Club member temperatures taken upon entering, Marked Social Distancing spots & Club staff signing in Club members,
- Any Club members or staff having Covid-19 symptoms will be sent home. Before be allowed back to Club facility a Covid-19 test will need to be administered by health care physician.
- Program areas of the Club will have a 10 Club member capacity and will offer social distancing programs & activities.
- Club members are HIGHLY encouraged to wear masks. Clubhouse will assist any Club members needing assistance in obtaining a mask. All Club staff are required to wear mandatory masks.
- Outside Summer Clubhouse Activities will not be offered for Club members. (Swimming, Bowling, Movies, etc.) Club will offer Inside Summer Clubhouse Activities. (Activity times & days will be posted up at front entrance.
- Lunch is provided to Club members and lunch will be at Clubhouse. Club members will be separated & split into groups in designated areas of the Club to eat lunch.
- All Club members that sign out & leave Club facility will forfeit spot at the Club for the day and will not be allowed back into Club facility until the next programming day.
- Clubhouse will be administering daily cleanliness & disinfecting of areas & equipment.

### Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

The Boys & Girls Clubs of the Nez Perce Tribe has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, the Club cannot GUARANTEE that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending the Club could increase your risk and your child(ren)'s risk of contracting COVID-19.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the Club and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Club may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, Club employees, volunteers, and program participants and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I or my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with my child(ren)'s attendance at the Club or participation in Club programming ("Claims"). On my behalf, and on behalf of my children, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the Club, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the Club, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any Club program.

Club Staff will not give Club members permission to leave the Club, nor will they insist stay. The decision as to when a Club member arrives and leaves the Boys & Girls Club, and with whom, is a matter between the parent and child. The staff assumes NO responsibility or liability as to custody, care and control. Any Club members signing out & leaving Club facility will not be allowed back in until the next programming day.

### Required Attendance Sign-In & Sign-Out

Club members will be signed in & out on the front counter computer by a Club Staff. Club member attendance is tracked as a helpful tracking tool for Clubhouse attendance & duration reports, as well as, assisting parents on their child(ren)'s attendance & times if needed. At the end of the program day, All Club members that are needing picked up must be by no later than 5:30pm. (\*Failure to do so on a consistent basis could result in local law enforcement being notified & transporting child home.)

### Health & Accidents

In the event of an emergency, a staff person will attempt to contact parents using the information on the Club membership registration form. **Parents please keep your home, work, and emergency contact information current.** In fairness to your child and others, please do not send your child to the Club when he/she is ill. Staff will notify a parent as soon as possible if your child becomes ill while at the Club. If a parent cannot be reached, Club staff will assess the situation and make the necessary decisions for the safety of the child.
